Anyone in our group that wants to take advantage of the indoor waterpark may purchase day passes for an additional \$20 per person. These passes would be purchased after you arrive at the resort.

There is a free Behind the Scenes, Underground Guided Waterpark Tour. There is a maximum of 15 people at a time and we would need to schedule times for these tours. The tour takes about 45 minutes and you need to be very mobile to take this tour. There are stairs involved so no walkers, canes, etc. will be allowed. Tours can be set up from 9:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. daily.

We have arranged for our group to go on a Gold Mine Tour. This tour takes about 30 minutes and includes an additional one hour of panning for gold if desired.

Adult pricing is \$10.00. Kids 4 – 16 are \$6.00. Under 4 are free

The mine is located 6 miles from the resort and our tour time is 1:00 p.m. You will pay for this at the mine so arrive a few minutes early to pay.

We will also be offering “Dice for Dogs”, a fundraising event for the Service Dog Project. We will have dice games to play from 2:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. More details to come at a later date.
