

1 **Proposed Amendment to Section 122A**

3 **SECTION 122A – EASTERN STAR TRAINING AWARDS FOR RELIGIOUS LEADERSHIP [See also Section 127**
4 **(5)]**

6 **CURRENTLY READS**

8 1. There is hereby created a fund to be known as the Eastern Star Training Awards for Religious
9 Leadership. This fund is to consist of contributions from Chapters and members and will be for the
10 purpose of giving assistance to young men and women who desire to enter fields of religious service
11 namely, ministers, missionaries, directors of church music, director of religious education and directors
12 of youth leadership.

13 2. To administer this fund, a standing committee to be known as the ESTARL Scholarship Awards
14 Committee shall be appointed and shall consist of three members; one of whom may be a Past Grand
15 Matron or Past Grand Patron, and all of whom shall have attained the rank of Worthy Matron or Worthy
16 Patron. The chairman shall be the member whose term of office next expires. At each Annual
17 Communication there shall be appointed one member to serve for a period of three years. (1999)

18 3. The standing committee shall be the governing board; shall rule on all applications and shall
19 authorize all disbursements. As nearly as possible or practical, all funds received each year shall be
20 disbursed to applicants.

22 4. Awards from this fund shall be made in accordance with procedures and regulations
23 formulated by the standing committee.

25 5. Awards are to be variable in amounts as determined by the standing committee, and will be
26 on the basis of funds available, number of applicants, and needs of individuals. Awards are to be made
27 for one year subject to renewal on basis of total record. Applicants need not be Masonic or Eastern Star
28 affiliation. (2012)

29 6. Awards are to be made in the form of a certificate presented to the student. The student is
30 free to select the accredited school of his or her choice. A check in the amount of the award will be sent
31 to the school, the money to be used for books, tuition, board and room, clothing, or medical aid. (1995)

32 7. Anyone who is not morally suitable for membership in the Order of the Eastern Star or anyone
33 currently under supervision of the judicial system is not eligible to receive financial benefits of an ESTARL
34 Scholarship from the Grand Chapter of Oregon. (2007)


48 **RATIONALE:** This brings the ESTARL Committee in line with the requirements set forth for the


