

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CHANGE THE BYLAWS

Needs 2/3 vote to pass at the same session it is read and voted on to become law. [Section 251 (3)]

2 **SECTION 220 - FEES**

3 **Now Reads:**

4 1. The fees for degrees shall be fixed by the Chapter, but shall not be less than Ten Dollars (\$10). (1971)

5 2. A fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) must accompany all petitions for affiliations and all petitions for
6 affiliation resulting in Plural membership, which fee shall be retained by the Chapter. [Section 128]
7 (2017)

8 3. A fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) must accompany a petition for reinstatement when petitioner has
9 been suspended for more than two years, which fee shall be retained by the Chapter. [Section 128]
10 (2017)

11 4. All new members will pay Five Dollars (\$5) for the International Eastern Star Headquarters as soon as
12 they become members of the chapter. This includes initiates, Plurals, and affiliates. The only exception
13 is when a member is reinstated. (2010) (2014)


